

Ford Bronco armrest cover – RedlineGoods

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1. Remove rear panel from back of arm rest by pulling firmly on the top left and right sides.



2. Open the arm rest. Use fingers or small flat head screwdriver to pry out center pin that holds the armrest to the console. (Pull all the way out). Remove armrest.



3. Turn armrest over and use plastic trim pry tool along left and right sides. Slide the pry tool in between the armrest pad and the hard plastic and pop out the pad from the plastic tabs that are holding the two together. Work the tool to the front and rear. The pad should pop right out with light force.



4. Lay the redline leather pad face down. Use 3M or equivalent spray adhesive onto the back of the leather pad.
5. Place the armrest onto leather pad firmly making sure to align correctly. Check instructions for the adhesive for details.
6. Once dried spray adhesive onto each sides of leather and pull tight and fold over plastic. (can use electric staple gun if need be, just make sure staples aren't long enough to puncture through top side)
7. Repeat process on the front and rear, making sure that everything is tight with no wrinkles or bubbles.
8. Once dried, place the armrest back onto plastic housing making sure everything is tight and secure.
9. Place armrest back onto console, aligning holes up with the factory bracket and slide the center pin back through.
10. Close armrest and make sure hinges function correctly.
11. Place rear cover back on console.
12. Enjoy your beautiful new armrest.
