

Honda Civic 2022+ armrest cover for cars with manual gearbox by *RedlineGoods*

Installation Instructions

Tools needed:

- Phillips screwdriver
- Stapler (useful, but not absolutely necessary)
- Trim tools
- Pick tools
- Needle nose pliers

Center console lid removal:

1. Remove the four Phillip's screws on the underside of the center console arm rest (two upper, two lower)
2. Using trim tools (or gently with your hands), release the six retainer clips
3. The upholstered center console arm rest portion is now free from the rest of the center console



Recovering the lid

1. There is enough material to add the new cover over the factory material. You can also remove the factory covering by removing the multiple staples. Use a pick tool or needle nose pliers to remove them all.
2. Center the new material and begin wrapping it over the arm rest.
3. Begin stapling the material onto the lid. Pull the material tight to ensure there aren't any wrinkles or imperfections.
4. Alternatively, you can use heavy duty leather/upholstery glue instead of stapler – glue the cover all over the armrest lid and, especially, the ends of material to the underside of the armrest lid.



Installation is reverse of removal
