Equipment used: • T50 security Torx

• Steering wheel puller

Torque specifications: Steering wheel to steering column bolt: 29-42 (22-31)

N-m (ft-lb) Airbag mounting bolts: 15-25 (11-18)

Steering Wheel Removal

Note: In all pictures, a 94 Villager was used. For all other model years, the approach remains similar.


Step 1

Disconnect the ground terminal from the battery and wait at least 10 minutes. Wrap a rag around the terminal to prevent it from accidentally contacting the battery post.



Step 2

Remove the trim covers on the left, right, and bottom of the steering wheel. Disconnect the electrical connector for the airbag then remove the bolts holding the airbag to the steering wheel. Remove the airbag carefully. Do not reuse the bolts.









Step 3


If the vehicle is not equipped with wheel controls, skip ahead to Step 4. Remove the two bolts holding down the cruise control buttons then disconnect the electrical connector. Removing radio control buttons will have a comparable process.





Step 4

Remove the screws as indicated. Keep note of their lengths and locations. Other configurations may have more or less fasteners than shown below.



Step 5

Mark the relationship between the wheel and the column. Then, using a steering wheel puller, remove the wheel.



Steering Wheel Wrap Installation

It is recommended, to save the hassle of dealing with wrapping the wheel, to <u>have the wheel wrapped by RedlineGoods</u> themselves. However, if one elects to go the DIY route, <u>RedlineGoods has an entire page dedicated to showing how to do this</u>. As such, the steps regarding how to wrap the wheel is omitted from this guide and one should refer to the links above to continue further.

Steering Wheel Installation

Installation is simply the reverse of removal. Torque the bolts to the specifications listed at the beginning of this guide and enjoy.
